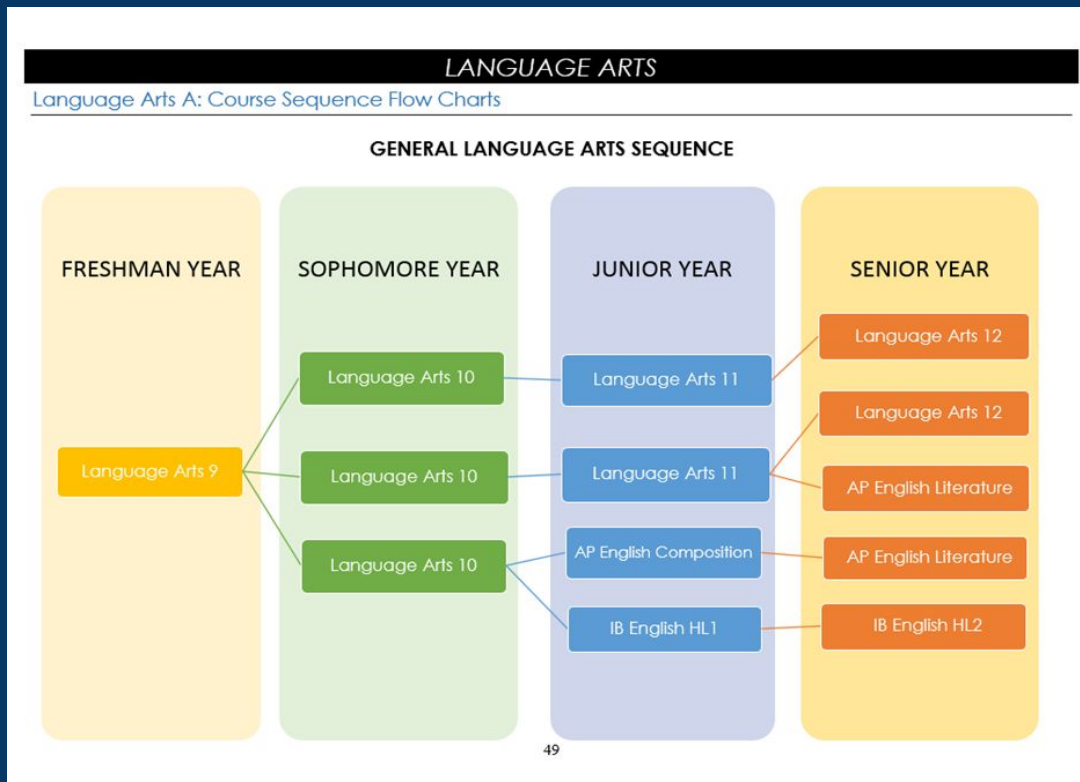

Choose Wisely!

Schedule Adjustments are only made for the following reasons:

- **Schedule is incomplete (does not have all 7 hours scheduled)**
- **There is a scheduled conflict (two classes are scheduled in the same hour)**
- **The Student previously failed or did not take the prerequisite course**
- **The Student is missing a course needed to fulfill a graduation requirement**

Schedule Adjustment Process:

- **Deadline for notifications of errors is the end of the first week of a new semester**
 - **A digital schedule error form will be available in the fall**
